Warrior Care

Purpose: To provide parents with a secure and dependable environment for their children's care during their commute or working hours.

Who can attend: Students who are enrolled in the district in grades 4K through 6th grade. Students must be toilet-trained.

When is it available for students? Any day that school is scheduled to be in session from 6:30 AM to 7:45 AM and/or 3:30 PM to 6 PM. Parents can drop off students at or after 6:30 AM or pick up before 6:00 PM.

- If school is delayed or cancelled, there will be no AM session
- If school is cancelled or released early (due to special circumstances/weather), there will be no PM session
- On scheduled early release days, families will have the option to extend their child's participation in the program for the additional time..

Intent to Attend: Parents will be asked to identify which days their children will be attending before and/or after school, the week preceding each month (e.g., by August 25 for September). This would allow the district to properly staff the program.

Fees:

- Registration fee: \$25/family (annually)
- AM portion: \$7/day
- PM portion: \$10/day
- Early Release days 1:30 to 3:30: An additional \$5/day (\$15 for 1:30 to 6:00)
- If a family has three or more children, the third child and any additional children will be discounted by \$1/session: (\$6 AM/\$9 PM)
- The district will not provide a 1:1 adult supervisor for a child whose IEP requires this during school time. We would seek a person to provide the support, given that the compensation comes from another source (family/community program/etc).

Fees for Late Pick-up:

- After 15 minutes: \$25/family
- After 30 minutes: \$50
- Etc.
- Phone calls to staff advising of late pickup will be appreciated.

Payment Method: Payments will be made via Revtrak

- Other methods of payment are available upon request and approval
- Prepayment is allowable/preferred
- Payments are due within 14 days of billing
- Invoices will be issued via email the Monday following the week of service/ arrangements can be made if a family does not have email access.

Food Available:

- Morning Breakfast is available through the school nutrition program at 7:45 AM (cost is not covered by the fee for morning Warrior Care, would be covered through the school food service plan)
- Afternoon Snack after school is provided (cost is covered by the Warrior Care program fee)

Activities to be potentially included in the program:

- Homework/Fun Pack time
- Afternoon Snack
- Recess/Play time outside, weather permitting
- Movies
- Board Games/Crafts

Example Daily Schedule:

Morning:

• Social Time/Games/Coloring/Reading/Homework - if an assignment is due that day

Afternoon:

- 3:30 Snack
- 3:45 Homework/Fun Packets/Reading
- 4:30 Recess or Indoor Physical Activity (weather dependent)
- 5:00 M/W/F Games T/R Movies/Crafts

Behavior Expectations:

- Parallel behavior expectations while in school
- Follow the timelines outlined in the program

Health Expectations:

- Children who are sick should not be in attendance.
- Parents will be contacted to pick up children who become sick during attendance at Warrior Care.
- Children should not attend until they are symptom-free or have been on medication for at least 24 hours.

Location:

• Black Hawk School Building - Upper Commons, Room 37, and/or School Playground

Circumstances that lead to removal from the program:

- Fees not paid within the 14-day timeline (removal until paid in full)
- Late Fees reaching \$100 (removal until paid in full)
- Behavior Issues three written reports and communicated with the parent/guardian at the time of each occurrence, potential removal for the remainder of the year.

Cancellation by Family:

If a family intends to discontinue the service, the district requests a two-week advance notice.
