scholarship committee containing the following information in four distinct paragraphs, limited to a maximum of 500 words:

Future Educational Plans and Goals: Applicants will describe their future occupational goals, and their upcoming plan in accomplishing those goals, which would include the educational institution that they are planning on attending, and potential major of study.

Scholarship and Coursework Summary: Applicants will list their total number of credits completed, class rank, and grade point average. Applicants should list all dual college credit courses, and/or advanced placement classes taken.

Extra-curricular Involvement and Honors: Applicants will list extracurricular organizations, activities, and athletics that they have been involved in over their high school career. Applicants will list the number of varsity letters earned over their four years of attending high school.

Citizenship and Character: Applicants will list the number of citizenship hours that they have accumulated over their high school career, and describe the different volunteer activities that they have been involved in, both inside and outside of the school environment. Students will describe their overall perception of their character providing examples of trustworthiness/honesty, dependability, and leadership.
