  - **Essay**: You are to type three (3) concise paragraphs. The first should indicate your educational plans and why you chose a certain school. The second should state your future career plans and why you chose this field. The third should state why you feel you need financial help. List specific reasons such as "my father is hospitalized and cannot work to send me to school" or "my parents are deceased and I have no means of support," etc. Type double-spaced and attach the separate sheet.
