Our district is facing critical financial challenges that need to be addressed with additional revenue. Our communities will consider a \$800,000 recurring referendum.

FAQ #12 WHAT IS THE TAX IMPACT OF THIS REFERENDUM?

Referendum Amount:	\$800,000
Average Mill Rate Impact (over 2026-2027) (Per \$1,000 Valuation)	Recurring \$2.24

TAX IMPACT ON PROPERTY WITH VALUES OF:

\$100,000 Property

Average Impact: \$224.00
Monthly Impact: \$18.67



\$300,000 Property

Average Impact: \$672.00
Monthly Impact: \$56.00

\$200,000 Property

Average Impact: \$448.00
Monthly Impact: \$37.33

Notes:

Estimated mill rates for the current and subsequent fiscal years may fluctuate due to factors beyond the district's control, including, but not limited to:

- Variations in state aid
- Changes in student enrollment
- Biennium budget adjustments
- Fluctuation in equalized property values
- Changes in salary and benefits
- Unforeseen expenditures (e.g. repairs, maintenance, curriculum needs)

To find the average increased tax impact of a property with a value equal to yours – take the Fair Market Value (as indicated on the tax bill) and multiply it by .00224.

Example: A property with a fair market value of \$280,000 – take $\$280,000 \times 0.00224 = \627.20
(this will be the average annual increase for a property with a fair market value of \$280,000)
