

Until further notification, starting Saturday, August 1; all individuals who enter the school building shall be wearing a face covering. Outside of the building a face covering will be required if a distance of 6' cannot be maintained.

For those individuals working summer school, and for families with students attending summer school:

Dear families of 2020 summer school students,

As you are probably aware, this afternoon, July 30, Governor Evers issued a statewide order on the requirement to wear face coverings in public spaces. We will be requiring that all students and staff wear a face covering when waiting to enter the school building for summer school, August 3rd - August 14th, and while they are in the school building, except for the following situations:

*1. While a single individual is giving a religious, political, media, **educational**, artistic, cultural, musical, or theatrical presentation for an audience, the single speaker may remove the face covering when actively speaking. While the face covering is removed, the speaker must remain at least 6 feet away from all other individuals at all times. **Ex. - teacher at front of class while actively giving instructions or modeling, while maintaining distance of 6' or more.***

2. While eating or drinking.

3. Individuals with medical conditions, intellectual or developmental disabilities, mental health conditions, or other sensory sensitivities that prevent the individual from wearing a face covering.

If your student(s) do not possess a face covering, one will be provided for your student upon arrival at school. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation. See you soon.

Notice to students and staff involved in athletic training:

Athletes in the building must wear a mask, which includes the weight room and gym.

Athletes training outside must wear a mask if they cannot maintain a 6' distance between them and any other person. If a 6' distance can be maintained they may remove the mask.
